

How to Make Materials

Number Cards, Teacher Deck

- 1) From the teacher number cards document:
 - Print 5 copies of page 1 (to label the back of the number cards).
 - Print 1 copy of pages 2–6 (the numbers 1–20).
- 2) Collate the copies to alternate front and back (1 page of numbers and then 1 page of labels).
- 3) Gather the appropriate color cardstock.
- 4) Copy the number cards onto the cardstock (1-sided original to 2-sided copy).
- 5) Cut out the cards along the lines.
- 6) Make 1 set per teacher.

Number Cards, Student Deck

- 1) From the student number cards document:
 - Print 5 copies of page 1 (to label the back of the number cards).
 - Print 1 copy of pages 2–6 (the numbers 1–20).
- 2) Collate the copies to alternate front and back (1 page of numbers and then 1 page of labels).
- 3) Gather the appropriate color cardstock.
- 4) Copy the number cards onto the cardstock (1-sided original to 2-sided copy).
- 5) Cut out the cards along the lines.
- 6) Make 1 set per student.

Story Mats

- 1) Print each story mat document on the appropriate color cardstock.
- 2) Laminate the story mats.
- 3) Make 6 copies of each story mat per teacher.

How to Make Materials (cont.)

Fast Dot Cards, Teacher Deck

- 1) From the teacher fast dot cards document:
 - Print 17 copies of page 1 (to label the back of the fast dot cards).
 - Print 1 copy of pages 2–18 (fast dot arrays).
- 2) Collate the copies to alternate front and back (1 page of fast dots and then 1 page of labels).
- 3) Gather the appropriate color cardstock.
- 4) Copy the fast dot cards onto the cardstock (1-sided original to 2-sided copy).
- 5) Cut out the cards along the lines.
- 6) Make 1 set per teacher.

Fast Dot Cards, Student Deck

- 1) From the student fast dot cards document:
 - Print 7 copies of page 1 (to label the back of the fast dot cards).
 - Print 1 copy of pages 2–8 (fast dot arrays).
- 2) Collate the copies to alternate front and back (1 page of fast dots and then 1 page of labels).
- 3) Gather the appropriate color cardstock.
- 4) Copy the fast dot cards onto the cardstock (1-sided original to 2-sided copy).
- 5) Cut out the cards along the lines.
- 6) Make 1 set per student.

Number Line

- 1) Print the number line document on the appropriate color cardstock.
- 2) Cut out the number lines and paste or tape them together between the 10 and the 11. Laminate if desired.
- 3) Make 6 copies per teacher.

How to Make Materials (cont.)

Number Line Mats

- 1) Print each number line mat document on an 11x17 size piece of the appropriate color cardstock. If the PDF file does not print at the size you expect, select File > Print, and then select an option from the Page Scaling menu. If this step does not work, print to regular paper and then enlarge the copy on a copier.
- 2) Laminate the mats.
- 3) Make 6 copies of each mat per teacher.
